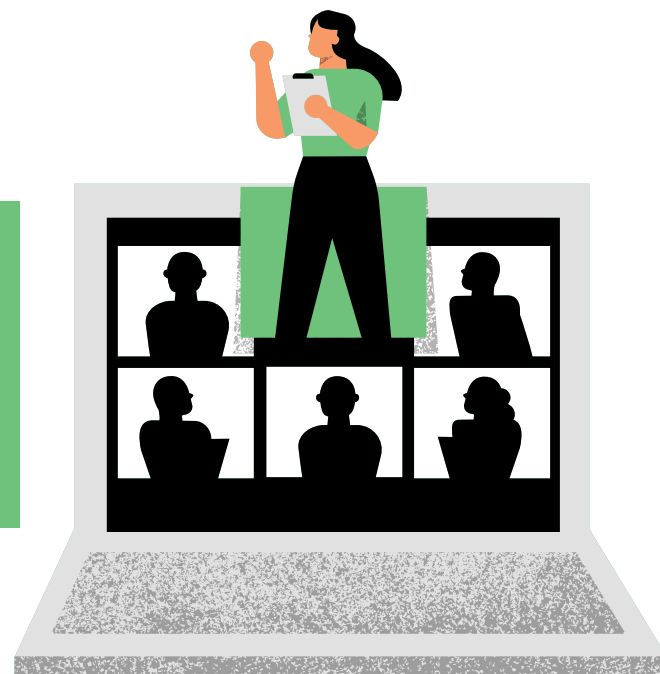

## ABOUT

The Violence Against Women Act was passed in 1994 and has been re-authorized several times by Congress. The most recent authorization in 2022 includes a new enforcement mechanism through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for federally funded housing programs. This presentation will cover the adverse factors victims/survivors can use to prevent being denied housing or being evicted because of abusers' actions that have impacted their credit, rental, and criminal histories.
